Founded in 2017, the [Erdős Institute](#) is a multi-university collaboration dedicated to helping Ph.D.s secure fulfilling jobs at every stage of their career. To date, the institute has supported over 5,000 graduate students, postdocs, and Ph.D. alumni, providing career exploration, training, and industry connections to a diverse community of academics. MSU Graduate Students and Postdocs have been participating since 2022 thanks to initial introductions through the Department of Mathematics. We'll discuss the historical development of the institute, its current programs, services and Ph.D. alumni network, as well as our collaborative model designed to address the universal problem of Ph.D. professional development.
