

AST 310, Astrophysics Directed Studies Application

Basic Information: Astrophysics directed study, also referred to as independent study, requires an agreement between the student and the faculty supervisor. AST 310 may be taken for 1-3 credits for a given semester, with a maximum of 12 total credits for all semesters of the course. With respect to the expected load, one credit is appropriate for a project that will require a total commitment of about 3 hours per week on average; two credits imply a 6-hour commitment, etc. The faculty supervisor is expected to determine and post the grade by the end of the semester (typically the Sunday before finals week).
